Report Highlights:

The South African Agricultural Economic Fact Sheet has been updated to include calendar year 2020. Bilateral agricultural trade between the United States and South Africa is expected to decrease by seven percent to US\$700 million in 2020, after a record level of US\$753 were reached in 2019. Major agricultural products traded between the two countries include, poultry, citrus, tree nuts, wheat, feed and fodder, planting seeds, processed fruit and wine.


General

- ❖ Covering 1.2-million square kilometers of land, South Africa is the 24th-largest country in the world and one-eighth the size of the United States.
- South Africa has a highly diversified agricultural sector which includes the production and value-added activities of all the major grains (except rice), oilseeds, deciduous and subtropical fruits, sugar, citrus, wine, vegetables, cattle, dairy, pigs, sheep, broilers, ostriches and eggs.
- The agricultural sector consists of about 40,000 commercial farmers, 200,000 smallholder farmers and two million subsistence farmers.
- South Africa is the largest agricultural producer on the African continent and is also a **net food exporter**.
- South Africa has **14 million hectares of arable land** available (13% of total land area) of which about 1.5 million hectares (or 10%) is under irrigation.
- The primary limitation to the agricultural sector is the availability of water, with uneven and unreliable rainfall and regular occurrences of drought.
- South Africa is the biotechnology leader on the African continent and among the top ten largest producer of Genetically Engineered (GE) crops in the world with 3.0 million hectares.




Sector Distribution of SA Agricultural Production:



Gross Value by Commodities:




Per Capita Consumption of Major Commodities






Trends in South Africa's Agricultural Trade:




Major Export Destinations (2020):




Major Agricultural Products Exported (2020):



Major Agricultural Import Countries (2020):




Major Agricultural Products Imported (2020):
