Barley Trade Quarterly

November 2018

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Report Highlights:

Saudi Arabia's barley imports for MY2018/19 are estimated at 8.5 million MT, up by approximately 12 percent from the USDA's official estimate of 7.6 million MT. The higher imports are needed to raise stock levels and meet demand. Last MY, Ukraine lost its dominance of the Saudi barley market to Russia. Russia exported about 2.3 million MT, followed by Ukraine with 1.8 million MT.

Quarterly Barley Report November 2018

The Kingdom's barley imports for MY 2018/19 are projected at 8.5 million MT, up by 900,000 MT compared to USDA's official forecast of 7.6 million MT. Post increased projected 2018/19 barley imports based on purchases of barley concluded by the Saudi Grains Organization (SAGO) for arrivals before the end December 2018. SAGO expects to receive more than 4.7 million MT of barley during the first six months of the current MY.

MY2017/18 total Saudi barley imports were about 8 million MT which is similar to the USDA official estimate but lower by about 2 percent to total imports about 8.1 million imported in MY2016/17.

SAGO signed three barley purchase contracts to import a total of 4,740,000 MT during July-December 2018, up about 32 percent from the same period last year. The organization increased imports for the first six months of this MY to build up stocks and insure consumption demands are met. Overall, SAGO is projected to import 8.5 million MT by the end of MY2018/19 to raise stock levels and meet demand.

This year's fall season started with heavy rains in most livestock raising regions. This is expected to reduce barley import demand for the second half of this MY. SAGO estimates domestic barley consumption at 8 million MT per year.

Though SAGO's total barley purchase in July-December 2017 was 3.6 million MT, the actual total barley that arrived in Saudi was 4,376,509 MT according to supplies data. SAGO has indicated that it received about 800,000 MT of barley purchased in MY 2016/17 in September 2017, which puts total July-December 2017 imports close to export data provided by supplying countries of 4,376,509 MT.

SAGO tends to import large quantities of grains when prices are attractive. As such, the organization may import more than projected barley quantities if prices become more competitive.

Russia overtook Ukraine as the largest feed barley supplier to Saudi Arabia for the first time in MY2017/18. During that period, Russia exported about 2.3 million MT or approximately 28.9 percent of total Saudi imports of 7.94 million MT. Ukraine was the second largest supplier with about 22.8 percent, followed by Germany by at 12.7 percent and Romania by 9.9 percent.
