Report Highlights:

So far this marketing year, the Saudi Grains Organization (SAGO) has issued two barley import tenders to import a total of 3.24 million MT of barley for arrivals from July to October 2018, an increase of about 6 percent compared to the total barley imported in the same period last year. Supplying countries data show that Saudi Arabia's barley imports in the first eleven months of MY2017/18 (Jul 2017-May 2018) totaled about 7.4 million MT, down by about 6 percent compared to the same period in MY2016/17. Total Saudi barley imports for the current marketing year are estimated at 8 million MT, similar to the total imported in MY2017/18.

Available data from exporting countries shows that during the eleven months of MY2017/18 (Jul 2017-May 2018), Saudi barley imports totaled about 7.4 million MT, a decline of about 5 percent compared to the same period of the previous MY. Data from SAGO places Saudi imports for June 2018 at approximately more than 600,000 MT, this brings total MY2017/18 Saudi barley imports to approximately 8 million MT, similar to the official USDA estimate. Total Saudi barley imports for MY2018/19 are projected at the MY2017/18 level.

So far this marketing year, SAGO has issued two barley import tenders to import a total of 3.24 million MT of barley for arrivals from July to October 2018, an increase of about 6 percent compared to the total barley imported in the same period last year.

Major Barley Suppliers

During July 2017-May 2018, Ukrainian lost its long time dominance of the Saudi imported barley market to Russia, which exported 28.7 percent of total Saudi feed barley imports. Ukraine was the second largest supplier with 23.7 percent market share, followed by Germany with 13.3 percent, Argentina with 10.4 percent and France with 9.6 market share. The U.S. has not exported feed barley to Saudi Arabia since MY2012/13, when U.S. exports totaled 58,696 MT.
