## **Beans and Pulses Monthly Report June 2012**

#### **Report Highlights:**

Burma exported 155,490 metric tons (MT) of beans and pulses in June, an increase of two percent from the same period in 2011. Of this total, 63 percent went to India or 97,784 MT, followed by China with 13 percent or 20,213 MT, and Singapore nine percent or 14,345 MT. Year—to-date exports for 2012 are 856,013 MT, 33 percent greater than last year's 645,915 MT.

# **General Information:** Trade

Burma's beans and pulses exports in June, 2012 totaled 155,490 MT, up two percent from 151,929 MT in June 2011. Matpe (black gram) accounted for 38 percent of the total exports, followed by Toor whole 35 percent and Mung bean at 18 percent. Year—to-date exports for 2012 are 856,013 MT, 33 percent greater than last year over the same period. India and China were the largest buyers accounting for 97,984 MT or 63 percent of total exports, and 20,213 MT or 13 percent of total exports, respectively.

#### **Export prospects**

June 2012 exports increased two percent as compared to the same month last year due to strong demand from India. Year –to-date exports for June 2012 are 856,013 MT, 33 percent greater than last year's 645,915 MT for the same period. Production continues to increase as farmers have shifted their cultivation preference to beans and pulses from rice during the summer season, due to higher returns. It is expected that total production this year will be 4.7 MMT a 6 percent increase from 2011. During the first six months of 2012, total exports have reached 0.85 million MT, Post expect annual exports for 2012 to reach 1.5 million MT, provided the Burmese Kyat exchange rate does not deteriorate significantly.
