India Food Retail Update as of Friday, October 16, 2020

- 1. New Delhi: The price of multiple vegetables, including potatoes, tomatoes, and onions, have increased rapidly due to heavy rains that have slowed down supply arrivals at markets. In Azadpur market, wholesale prices for potatoes and onions have increased by 219 and 180 percent, respectively.
- **2. Visakhapatnam:** Edible oil prices have increased by 30 percent due to higher demand and a slowdown in palm and sunflower oils imports from Malaysia and Ukraine.
