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Report Highlights:

Saudi Arabian barley imports totaled approximately 2.63 million metric tons (MMT) during the eight months of the marketing year (MY) 2021/2022, which is a decrease of approximately 41 percent compared to the same time period last year. Since the start of the war in Ukraine, Australia has become the exclusive barley supplier to Saudi Arabia and many traders anticipate that trend will continue over the next year.

Quarterly Analysis - Barley

Available data from exporting countries shows that during the eight months of MY 2021/2022 (July 2020-Feb 2021), Saudi barley imports totaled approximately 2.63 MMT, a decrease of approximately 41 percent compared to the previous MY. During that period, Australia was the leading feed barley supplier to the Kingdom with 55 percent of the market share followed by the European Union (EU) at 20 percent. Ukraine and Russia were both at 13 percent. Since the start of the war in Ukraine, Australia has become the exclusive barley supplier to Saudi Arabia. Many traders anticipate that trend will continue over the next year and informed Post that Australia will supply even more of Saudi Arabia's demands due to a huge barley crop this MY, improvements in freight shipments, and competitive prices compared to the EU.

The current cost and freight (CFR) price per metric ton (MT) for Australian barley at Saudi Arabian seaports ranges between \$415 - 420, an increase of \$100 per MT compared to prices before the war started between the two Black Sea countries. Some Saudi importers have reportedly purchased several vessels of Australian barley for arrival between July - September. Currently, the price of barley from the EU is \$450 per MT for a July - August arrival.

Imported Barley Versus Locally Produced Animal Feed

Currently, a 50-kg of barley is sold for \$21.16 inclusive of the 15% value added tax (VAT) at packing terminals while the same quantity was sold for \$19.32 in February 2022 while ARASCO (Arabian Agricultural services company) maintained the wholesale price of its 50-kg bag of "Wafi" compound feed at least 7 Saudi Riyal (SAR), or \$1.87 USD, below the price of barley of the same weight. ARASCO maintains a lower price to educate livestock farmers about the cost savings and weight gain benefits of its feed compared to grain barley. ARASCO says a 1-kg of its processed complete feed (Wafi) replaces 1.5 kg of grain barley. According to various experts, replacing grain barley with processed feed will benefit livestock farmers by lowering the overall costs in the long term since processed feed is consumed more easily than barley. The Saudi Ministry of Environment, Water and Agriculture (MEWA) reports that more than 30 percent of

raw barley fed to livestock is discharged without being digested; thereby, providing no benefit to animals in terms of weight gain or nutrition.
