# Completion of the First 2016 U.S. Rice CSQ Normal Tender for Glutino

#### **Report Highlights:**

On May 6, Taiwan completed a normal tender GF4-105-041 for 1,000 MT of U.S. short grain milled glutinous rice.

#### **General Information:**

Result of May 6 Glutinous Rice Tender is as follows.

<u>GF4-105-041 for 1,000 MT(1,150 MT brown equivalents) of U.S.-origin Short Grain Milled Glutinous</u> <u>Rice:</u> completed at its 1<sup>st</sup> tender on May 6.

On May 6, Taiwan awarded the tender to two winning bidders out of five who participated in the bid, 500 MT each at the same price of NT\$34,866/MT or US\$1,076.74 (Exchange rate: US\$1 = NT\$32.381 on 05/06/2016) for delivery from October 1-December 31, 2016.

According to Council of Agriculture's Agriculture and Food Agency (AFA), the remaining 27,884 MT of the 2016 U.S. Rice CSQ under normal tender scheme will be divided into three to five tenders for long grain or medium grain.
