Report Highlights:

Global Affairs Canada published policy options for the allocation and administration rules for all tariff rate quotas (TRQs) related to supply-managed products (i.e., dairy, poultry and eggs). Comments on the proposed options will be accepted through April 3, 2020. Keywords: Canada, TRQ, Supply Management, Consultation





On February 14, 2020, Global Affairs Canada (GAC) published proposed options for the <u>allocation</u> and <u>administration</u> of tariff rate quotas created by multiple trade agreements' market access commitments (i.e., WTO Uruguay Round, CETA, CPTPP, and USMCA). The <u>public consultation</u> period on the <u>policy options</u> will run through April 3, 2020, commencing the second phase of a comprehensive review of supply-managed TRQs initiated in May 2019.

In addition, the consultation website indicates that "input from respondents does not have to be limited to the options presented; respondents can identify other potential options for any component of the allocation or administration of supply-managed TRQs".

To assist stakeholders engaged in the consultation process, GAC also provided detailed <u>background information</u> on Canada's various TRQs, including the current applicable allocation and administration rules.
