# Another Successful U.S. Common Wheat Tender

#### **Report Highlights:**

Following a fully successful tender for US wheat in late 2017 and in the midst of a difficult growing season, Morocco fully committed to its common wheat tender with the European Union at 363,636 MT and nearly fully committed to the US wheat tender at 315,000 MT. No significant changes are made to the PSD balance sheets aside from accepting official year-end trade data while adjusting trade figures to account for wheat products.

### **Crop Update**

The 2018 wheat season started very late, due to widespread rain delays, and some areas did not finish sowing until late December 2017. According to press reports, Morocco's High Commission for Planning's January survey indicated that mid-December 2017 water reserves for agricultural use were at their lowest levels of the last six crop years – 32%. At present, industry analysts are projecting wheat production to come in at a range of 3.0-5.5 MMT. Post's estimate for MY2018/19 will be published in its Grain & Feed Annual report in March 2018.




Figure 1: Morocco – Relative Crop Conditions (MODIS NDVI 8-day)

### **Policy Updates:**

Since the September update, Morocco issued a successful tender for US wheat in Oct/Nov 2017 (See: <u>US Common Wheat TRQ Fully Allocated in 2017</u>) for deliveries by December 31, 2017 as well as tenders for US and EU wheat for deliveries by May 31, 2018 (See: <u>US and EU Wheat Tenders Issued</u>) – the results of which are were published January 8-9, 2018, and are noted in the below table.

In Morocco's <u>2018 Finance Law</u>, the government has lowered the MFN duty to 2.5% for a new, to-be-confirmed quota volume of imported "biscuit wheat" to support industrial manufacturers of cookies, crackers, cakes, wafers, etc. Press reports indicate the volume will be set at 40,000 MT.

### **Trade Updates:**

#### Wheat

Post revised its forecast for Morocco's MY2017/18 wheat imports from the U.S. from 10,000 MT to 345,000 MT. This change is based on the result of the most recent two tenders. Post also updates MY and TY import and export numbers in 2015/16 and 2016/17, based on final official trade data and taking into consideration trade of wheat products.

### **Barley**

Post maintains its estimate for MY2017/18 (No changes). For MY 2016/17, post updates MY and TY imports based on final official trade figures.
