Report Highlights:


Post's forecast wheat and barley production is unchanged from USDA's current official estimates. As expected, Morocco renewed its domestic support program for MY 2018/19 without significant changes and increased the MFN import duty on common wheat to 135% ahead of harvest. The high seasonal tariff is set to remain in place through October 31, 2018.

Crop Update

Following Post's initial forecast on March 31, Morocco's wheat and barley crops were able to finish developing under ideal conditions in April and May, as suggested by Morocco's record high vegetation index scores.

Officially, the Ministry of Agriculture has held its April 24 production estimate for cereal production at 9.8 MMT, including 4.81 MMT of common wheat, 2.28 MMT of durum wheat, and 2.73 MMT of barley, while press reports June 22 indicated the Ministry now expected cereal production to top 10 MMT, a level generally agreed by local professionals. Final production numbers are expected in late July/early August.

Policy Update

Common Wheat Import Duties Increased to 135%: On May 11, 2018, Morocco announced the MFN import duty on common wheat would increase from 30% to 135% , effective May 14 through October 31, 2018, and in so doing, increased the preferential rates for US and EU wheat from 9.9% to 83.7% . U.S. Common Wheat TRQ Fill: The United States has delivered an estimated 330,000 MT against its 400,000 MT calendar year quota in 2018. The remaining portion will be re-auctioned for delivery later in 2018.

¹ This rate is applied to the first 1000 dh/MT of unit value while a rate of 2.5% is applied to the unit value >1000 dh/MT. Assuming a unit value of 1400 dh/MT, the applied MFN duty is calculated as (135% * 1000 / 1400) + (2.5% * 400 / 1400) = 97.1%, and the applied U.S. duty is (83.7% * 1000 / 1400) + (2.5% * 400 / 1400) = 60.5%.

Common Wheat Reference Prices and Subsidies Maintained: On May 10, 2018, Morocco's National Cereal Office (ONICL) renewed its support measures, effective May 16-October 15, 2018, with effectively no changes:

- Reference price for local common wheat maintained at 2,800 Dh/MT (≈\$299/MT)
- Biweekly storage subsidy maintained at 20 Dh/MT (≈\$2.1/MT).
- Miller subsidy for local wheat purchases maintained at 100 Dh/MT (\approx \$10.7/MT)
- National flour price maintained at 2,588 Dh/MT (≈\$277/MT).

Biscuit Wheat Tariff-Rate Quota (TRQ) Established: To support industrial food manufacturers, Morocco established an MFN TRQ for 40,000 MT of biscuit wheat with an in-quota rate of 2.5%. Following TRQ administration questions early in the year, the quota has proved successful at facilitating SRW trade.
