Grain and Feed Update

U.S. Rice Exports Continue, But the Local Sale of Imported Short and Medium Grain Rice (from the U.S. and Other Origins) is Delayed.

Report Highlights:

Korea continues to meet its mandatory import volume of 408,700 metric tons (MT) from Most Favored Nation (MFN) countries, with purchases of 138,610 MT (milled) from the United States in CY 2017. Of this total, Korea purchased 37,000 MT of milled rice for table use from the United States. Although imports continue, auctions of medium and short grain rice imported under the 2015

TRQ have been suspended since September 18, 2017 due to pressure from domestic farmers. In early 2018, Korea plans to decrease some of its stocks by donating rice as food assistance through the ASEAN Plus Three Emergency Rice Reserve (APTERR) and through the Food Assistance Convention.

Although the previous arrangement requiring Korea to provide U.S. rice producers with a country-specific quota has expired at the end of 2014, Korea has continued to import the mandatory import volume of 408,700 MT from Most Favored Nation (MFN) countries at the current duty level of five percent under the tariff rate quota (TRQ) regime. As of December 27, 2017 Korea completed purchasing the remainder of the 2017 MFN TRQ: 215,300 MT of which was delivered in CY 2017 (May-December) and 193,400 MT which is scheduled to be delivered in CY 2018 (January-May) on the basis of contractual terms (Table 6).

2017 TRQ Tendering Results:

The Korea Agro-Fisheries and Food Trade Corporation (aT) completed the tendering process for the 2017 rice **TRQ** commitments on December 27, 2017. Korea purchased a total of 408,700 MT of rice (milled basis) from five countries, including the United States, China, Thailand, Australia, and Vietnam. The U.S. share was 33.9 percent, down 6.7 percentage points from the previous year, due to less competitive pricing than other countries despite greater demand for medium grain variety rice (Table 2). Contracts for U.S. rice totaled 138,610 MT (milled), worth USD 112.6 million. Of this total, 112,900 MT was brown rice (equivalent to 101,610 MT on a milled basis) used for food processing purposes and the remaining 37,000 MT was milled rice for table use (Table 1).

The Korean government purchased 40,000 MT of USDA No. 1 Grade milled rice for table use, down 10,000 MT from the previous year. This total consisted of 37,000 MT of medium grain from the United States and 3,000 MT of long grain from Vietnam. Korean domestic political circles continued pressing the Korean government to reduce the scale of table rice imports under the TRQ regime, blaming imported table rice for further disruption of domestic rice farm gate prices and also for the currently large rice stocks.

The average contracted price for U.S. #1 medium grain table rice was USD 826.75/MT, up 20 percent from the previous year. Meanwhile, Vietnamese #1 long grain table rice was contracted at USD 489.75/MT.

Auctions for Imported Table Rice:

Through a public auction system, Korea Agro-Fisheries & Food Trade Corporation (aT) sells table rice shipments to wholesalers and retailers for eventual sale to consumers. Meanwhile, the Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs (MAFRA) distributes processing rice to end-users such as food processors and alcoholic beverage producers at a set price throughout the year.

Due to heavy stocks of domestic rice caused by consistent crop overproduction since 2013, the current pace of auctions for imported rice for table use has been very slow, effectively reducing the volume of auctioned rice.

Since September 18, 2017, the government has suspended auctions for medium and short grain table rice imported under the 2015 TRQ, because farmers' groups have petitioned the government to slow down auctions for imported rice for table use. They have also asked the government to stop conducting auctions for imported medium and short grains that compete with domestic rice. However, the Korean government has continued selling auctions for long grain table rice imported from Thailand under the 2016 TRQ, as long grain rice doesn't compete with domestic short grain rice.

Food Aid under APTERR

In the wake of natural damage caused by Typhoon Damrey, MAFRA has stated that Korea will provide rice assistance of 10,000 MT (milled basis, 2016 crop) to Vietnam under the APTERR (ASEAN Plus Three Emergency Rice Reserve) program. Korea plans to deliver the rice to Vietnam in the first quarter of 2018. This is the second time Korea has given rice assistance to foreign countries since joining APTERR. The first time was in May 2017, when Korea delivered 750 MT to two Asian countries: 500 MT to Myanmar and 250 MT to Cambodia.

APTERR was established to provide member countries with rice in the event of natural disasters. The total amount of rice agreed upon in July 2013 by the 13 member countries and stored in reserve was 787,000 MT, including 150,000 MT promised by Korea. The Korean government has purchased 100,000 MT of domestic rice (milled basis) towards this commitment since 2014. Korea hopes to give greater amounts of assistance in the future, which will help alleviate the rice surplus in Korea.

Food Assistance Convention (FAC)

Since the Korean National Assembly ratified the agreement on December 1, 2017, Korea is ready to submit an application to join the Food Assistance Convention (FAC) in early 2018, and plans to donate 50,000 MT of domestic rice (milled basis) to five countries in Africa and Middle East through the World Food Program (WFP). Korea is expected to make a first shipment drawing from the 2016 rice crop in the first quarter of 2018.

STOCKS

The MY 2017/18 ending stocks forecast (as of the end of October 2018) is slightly down from the previous report at 1.23 MMT, or 25.3 percent of total forecast domestic consumption, due to the inclusion of the scheduled donation of 10,000 MT in early 2018 into the export account of PSD. MY 2016/17 ending stocks (as of the end of October 2017) are 36.7 percent of total estimated domestic consumption, remaining almost unchanged from the previous estimate, as just 750 MT of donated rice was included into export account of PSD.
