Report Highlights:

The Greek Feta cheese is a national symbol of a country that has been hard hit by the Eurozone crisis and where national pride has taken a battering. The feta industry accounts for more than 70 percent of Greek cheese exports (\$393 million in 2013) and—unlike much of the struggling Greek economy—it is expanding. Approximately 300,000 Greek livestock farmers earn a living from feta cheese.
