In view of ASEAN- India Free Trade Agreement (AIFTA), the Government of India (GOI) Ministry of Finance has issued an official Gazette notification, announcing tariff duty concessions to nine ASEAN countries (Malaysia, Thailand, Singapore, Vietnam, Myanmar, Indonesia, Brunei Darussalam, Lao People's Democratic Republic and the Philippines). Customs notification No. 46/2011 supersedes Notification No.153/2009.
