**Report Highlights:**

On December 7, 2023, the Veterinary Service at the Ministry of Agriculture of the Kyrgyz Republic informed the U.S. Department of Agriculture in writing that they will no longer accept the U.S. Department of Agriculture's, Food Safety Inspection Service, 9060-5 Meat and Poultry Export Certificate of Wholesomeness. USDA is actively working to resolve this issue.

On December 7, 2023, the Veterinary Service at the Ministry of Agriculture of the Kyrgyz Republic informed the U.S. Department of Agriculture in private correspondence that they will no longer accept the U.S. Department of Agriculture's, Food Safety Inspection Service, 9060-5 and 9060-5B Meat and Poultry Export Certificate of Wholesomeness and Continuation Sheet, and Fish and Fish Products Export Certificate of Wholesomeness 9060-5S.

The U.S. government is actively engaged in trying to reopen the market and is working to resolve the issue with utmost haste.
