Despite the lack of new inquiries from foreign buyers during the holiday season, export prices increased slightly as some exporters reportedly sought new-crop 5% grade white rice for shipment under the 2014 Government-to-Government Agreement with China, which totaled 1 million metric tons. Presently, exporters are shipping the 9th allotment of 100,000 metric tons, which was finalized in late December 2015. The shipment is taking place in January thru February 2016. Also, rumors indicate that the remaining 140,000 metric tons under the agreement with China will be finalized no later than January 2016.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial preliminary rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) for January 1-3, 2016 totaled 208 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – December 31, 2015, totaled 4,425,469 metric tons, down 18 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, starting May 1, 2013, the data will not include 100% - 25% grade white rice exports. The reporting authority was moved from the That Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official fragrant rice and white rice (100%-25% grades) export data. FAS/BKK will report only official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thatland. The reader should bear in mind the difference between the data.
