Report Highlights:

TH6034 – Export prices declined 1 percent due mainly to the weakening of the Thai baht. The tenders for 642,498 metric tons of food and non-food grade rice stocks scheduled for March 30-31 are likely to be competitive.

Export prices declined around 1 percent due mainly to the weakening of the Thai baht (34.7 baht/US\$ last week compared to 35.2 baht/US\$). The government expects 42 traders to participate in the public tender for food-grade rice totaling 418,736 metric tons on March 30, 2016. This tender is anticipated to be more competitive than the February 16, 2015 offer as 5% grade white rice will be included in the mix and supplies of new-crop white rice are currently tight. In addition, the tender for non-food grade rice of 223,762 metric tons on March 31 is also likely to remain attractive among feed mills due to current shortage of broken white rice.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial preliminary rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) for March 21-27, 2016 totaled 62,072 metric tons, up 3,247 metric tons from the previous week, but down 9,806 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 71,877 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – March 27, 2016 totaled 985,396 metric tons, up 16 percent from the previous week.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, starting May 1, 2013, the data will not include 100% - 25% grade white rice exports. The reporting authority was moved from the That Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official fragrant rice and white rice (100%-25% grades) export data. FAS/BKK will report only official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thatland. The reader should bear in mind the difference between the data.
