Report Highlights:

TH5098 – Export prices declined 1 percent due to continued weakening of Thai baht and lack of inquiries. Traders are awaiting the result of public tender for around 0.7 million metric tons issued on August 10.

Export prices declined around 1 percent from the previous week due to the weakening of Thai baht, which depreciated further to 35.14 baht/US\$ compared to 35 baht/US\$ in the previous week. Also, exporters reportedly received just a few inquiries from foreign buyers this week. In addition, results have yet to be reload from the public tender which was issued on August 10. Sources indicated that 58 bidders participated in the tender for 668,229 metric tons, half of which was 5% grade white rice from MY2013/14 main-crop rice pledging program. Most of participants are exporters and traders. Reportedly, the bidding was approximately 20 percent below current market prices.

Unofficial preliminary rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) for August 3-9, 2015 totaled 66,236 metric tons, down 24,012 metric tons from the previous week and down 13,986 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 80,222 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) from January 1 – August 9, 2015, totaled 2,377,650 metric tons, down 21 percent from the same period last year.

Total rice exports from January to June 2015 totaled 4,457,927 metric tons, down 4.7 percent from the same period last year (See GAIN Report – TH5094 Grain and Feed Update, June 2015).

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, starting May 1, 2013, the data will not include 100% - 25% grade white rice exports. The reporting authority was moved from the That Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official fragrant rice and white rice (100%-25% grades) export data. FASBKK will report only official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thatland. The reader should bear in mind the difference between the data.
