Weekly Rice Price Update

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Report Highlights:

TH2089 – Export prices declined slightly due to the government stock release of 229,661 metric tons, most of which were 5% grade white rice for export use only. Also, the National Rice Policy Committee finalized the MY2012/13 Paddy Pledging Program, which is expected to pledge a larger amount of paddy than this year's level.

Export prices declined about 1.0 percent from the previous week due to the government stock release. The Commerce Ministry decided on September 3 to release 229,661 metric tons of rice out of the 709,731 metric tons tender (from the MY2011/12 main-crop Paddy Pledging Program) that was announced on August 28, 2012 (Table 2). Almost all of the stock release is 5% grade white rice which is for export use only. The bidding prices were finalized at \$524-532/MT which is around 7.0 percent below market prices. The winners are the top-five rice exporters who are fulfilling their pending shipments to Iraq. Meanwhile, new inquiries from foreign buyers remain quiet. The Government will conduct a new tender by the end of September. The details of the tender have not yet been finalized. Currently, the Government is holding total intervention stocks of around 12-13 million metric tons; of which 1-2 million metric tons are old-crop rice. The MY2011/12 Paddy Pledging Program has pledged 18.8 million metric tons of paddy (12.4 million metric tons milled equivalent); of which 6.8 million metric tons are main-crop paddy (4.5 million metric tons milled equivalent) (Table 3), and 12.0 million

metric tons are off-season crop paddy (7.9 million metric tons milled equivalent) (Table 4). The total weekly pledging declined to 767,856 metric tons of paddy, down 8.3 percent (836,999 metric tons) from two weeks ago. Meanwhile, the National Rice Policy Committee has finalized the MY2012/13 Paddy Pledging Program which will be effective between October 1, 2012 – September 30, 2013. The intervention prices remain unchanged at 13,800 - 15,000 baht/tons (\$444 - 482/MT) for white rice paddy, and 18,000 - 20,000 baht/ton (\$579 - 643/MT) for fragrant rice paddy. No limit restrictions were imposed on the pledged amount. Presently, farm-gate prices are around 11,500 - 12,000 baht/ton (\$370 - 386/MT) for white rice paddy, and 14,800 - 16,000 baht/ton (\$476 - 514/MT) for fragrant rice paddy.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial rice exports (excluding fragrant rice) for August 27 – September 2, 2012 totaled 55,693 metric tons, down 21,668 metric tons from the previous week, and down 70,683 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 70,683 metric tons. Exports of white rice and parboiled rice between January 1- September 2, 2012 totaled 3,300,515 metric tons, down 50.2 percent (6,622,705 metric tons) from last year.

According to the Department of Foreign trade, Ministry of Commerce, total rice exports (including fragrant rice) between January 1 – August 29, 2012 amounted to 4,403,245 metric tons, down 46.0 percent (8,156,360 metric tons) from last year.
