Rice export prices further increased 2-3 percent mainly due the strengthening of the Thai baht.

Export prices of most rice grades grew 2-3 percent from the previous week as the Thai baht strengthened to \$1.00=36.59 baht from the previous week's exchange rate of \$1.00=36.65 baht. Exporters continue to secure rice supplies to fulfill the contracted shipments of white rice to ASEAN countries. Farm-gate prices of white paddy rice also increased one percent from the previous week as farmers have already harvested 87 percent of the MY 2023/24 off-season rice.

## **Rice Export Update**

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for April 29 – May 5, 2024, totaled 164,150 metric tons, down 27,084 metric tons from the previous week and up 8,639 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 155,511 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 to May 5, 2024, totaled 2,920,311 metric tons, up 40 percent compared to the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards took over reporting authority for rice exports and at that time the export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports. Prior to May 1, 2013, and since December 18, 2016, the Thai Board of Trade has reported rice export data, which includes 25%-100% grade white rice. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
