Report Highlights:

Rice export prices dropped one percent despite the strengthening of the Thai baht.

Rice export prices of most grades of Thai rice dropped one percent from the previous week despite the strengthening of the Thai baht, the highest rate since January 16, 2024, of \$1.00=35.08 baht from the previous week's exchange rate of \$1.00=36.12 baht. Domestic rice prices also dropped one percent from the previous week as new supplies of off-season rice in the central plains continued to enter the market.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for July 22 - 28, 2024, totaled 129,264 metric tons, up 32,053 metric tons from the previous week and up 7,854 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 121,410 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 to July 28, 2024, totaled 4,841,740 metric tons, up 35 percent compared to the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards took over reporting authority for rice exports and at that time the export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports. Prior to May 1, 2013, and since December 18, 2016, the Thai Board of Trade has reported rice export data, which includes 25%-100% grade white rice. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
