Report Highlights:

Rice export prices increased 2-8 percent from the previous week as exporters reportedly continued to secured rice supplies to fulfill contract shipments.

Rice export prices for most grades of Thai rice increased 2-8 percent from the previous week despite the weakening of the Thai baht to \$1.00=33.25 baht from the previous week's exchange rate of \$1.00=33.14 baht. Exporters reportedly continued to secure the rice supplies to fulfill contract shipments.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for October 7 - 13, 2024, totaled 181,057 metric tons up 12,751 metric tons from the previous week and up 27,516 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 153,541 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 to October 13, 2024, totaled 6,597,160 metric tons, up 32 percent compared to the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards took over reporting authority for rice exports and at that time the export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports. Prior to May 1, 2013, and since December 18, 2016, the Thai Board of Trade has reported rice export data, which includes 25%-100% grade white rice. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
