## **Report Highlights:**

Export rice prices went up strongly for high quality rice due to high export demand. Medium and low quality rice prices also increased, but more slightly, due mainly to the higher local paddy prices.

Despite the ongoing harvest of Spring crop in the Mekong River Delta, local paddy rice prices increased slightly last week due to rice purchasing for export deliveries and the government's one million ton rice purchase program to increase stocks.
