Domestic and export prices increased around 1-2 percent from the previous week due to tighter exportable supplies. Sales of government rice stocks remained suspended as the National Anti-Corruption Commission (NACC) continue to investigate the transparency of past government rice sales transactions. The current MY2012/13 main-crop Paddy Pledging Program has preliminarily received pledges of around 6.0 million metric tons of rice paddies (roughly 4.0 million metric tons milled equivalent) from October 1 – December 20, 2012, which is an increase of approximately 70 percent from the same period last year.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial rice exports (excluding fragrant rice) for December 17-23, 2012 totaled 100,333 metric tons, up 21,557 metric tons from the previous week and up 23,683 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 76,649 metric tons. Exports of white and parboiled rice from January 1- December 23, 2012

totaled 4,899,716 metric tons, down 40.2 percent (8,187,068 metric tons) from last year. According to the Department of Foreign trade, Ministry of Commerce, total rice exports (including fragrant rice) from January 1 – November 30, 2012 amounted to 6,405,420 metric tons, down 36.5 percent (10,083,416 metric tons) from the same period last year.
