Export prices remained unchanged from the previous week due to minimal trading during the current political environment. The Thai Prime Minister dissolved the parliament on December 9, 2013 and called for new elections to diffuse the current political turmoil. Despite the chaos, the current MY2013/14 main-crop rice paddy pledging program, which began on October 1, 2013, will continue until February 28, 2014. The government has reportedly received approximately 6 million metric tons of rice paddy (4 million metric milled equivalent - Table 2). The pledges consist of 4 million metric tons of white rice paddy (2.7 million metric tons milled equivalent) and 2 million metric tons of fragrant rice paddy (1.3 million metric tons milled equivalent). The continuance of the off-season rice paddy pledging program (March 1 – September 30, 2014) will depend on the new government.

#### **Rice Export Update**

Unofficial rice exports (excluding premium white rice and fragrant rice) for December 2-8, 2013 totaled 97,078 metric tons, up 7,044 metric tons from the previous week and up 19,734 metric tons from the four- week moving average of 77,344 metric tons (Table 3). Exports of white and parboiled rice from January 1 through December 8, 2013 totaled 3,117,814 metric tons, down 34 percent from 4,718,666 metric tons in the same period last year, mainly due to a reduction in parboiled rice exports.

Total rice exports (including premium white rice and fragrant rice) from January 1 through November 20, 2013 amounted to approximately 5.7 million metric tons, down 8.1 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: \*\* Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, starting May 1, 2013, the data will not include 100% - 25% grade white rice exports. The reporting authority was moved from the That Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official fragrant rice and white rice (100%-25% grades) export data. FAS/BKK will report only official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind the difference between the data.
