Weekly Rice Price Update

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Report Highlights:

Export prices remain unchanged as a result of the lack of rice trading during the year-end holiday season. Figures from the on-farm pledging program show that the volume of pledged rice is far below the targeted quantity.

Export prices for all grades of rice remain unchanged from the previous week due to the lack of rice trading during the year-end holiday season. Traders expect rice trading to fully resume by the second week of January 2018. Despite the holiday season, rice exporters are still actively seeking new-crop rice supplies to fulfill their outstanding shipment contracts of white and parboiled rice.

The government reported that since November 1, 2017, the main crop rice support programs had absorbed approximately 0.8 million metric tons of paddy rice, 20 percent of the target. The 0.8 million metric tons consist of (1) 738,915 metric tons of paddy rice under the 2.5 million metric ton target soft loan program for farmer institutions to hold paddy rice, and (2) 28,809 metric tons under the 2 million metric ton target on-farm pledging program. High market prices are the primary reason for the low participation rates in these programs

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) for December 11-17, 2017, totaled 194,947 metric tons, up 16,207 metric tons from the previous week and down 9,183 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 204,130 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – December 17, 2017, totaled 8,907,936 metric tons.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, during May 1, 2013 - December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% - 100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FASBKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
