Export price quotations increased 5-20 USD/MT, up 1-3 percent from the previous week. This increase reflects a correction in domestic prices as trader forecasts of MY2016/17 main-crop rice production were overly optimistic. Domestic prices of white rice increased around 2 percent from the previous week to 7,360 - 7,560 baht per metric ton (208 - 214 USD/MT). Similarly, domestic prices of fragrant rice paddy increased to 9,890 - 10,725 baht per metric ton (279 – 303 USD/MT), also up 2 percent from the previous week. New inquiries over the past week were limited to just small shipments.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial preliminary rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) for November 28 – December 4, 2016 totaled 62,278 metric tons, down 18,195 metric tons from the previous week and down 24,198 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 86,476 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – December 4, 2016 totaled 3,927,920 metric tons, down 2 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, starting May 1, 2013, the data will not include 100% - 25% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the That Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official fragrant rice and white rice (100%-25% grades) export data. FAS/BKK will report only official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thatland. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing with historical data.
