Rice Export Update

According to the Ministry of Commerce, rice exports during January 1 – November 30, 2018 totaled 10,077,219 metric tons. This is a 4 percent reduction from the 10,518,112 metric tons exported during January 1 – November 30, 2017 due to reduced exports of fragrant and parboiled rice. Fragrant rice exports totaled 1.9 million metric tons, down 23 percent from the same period last year due to tight exportable supplies after the sale of the remaining government food quality rice fragrant stocks in 2017. Parboiled rice exports totaled 2.5 million metric tons, down 16 percent from the record high exports in 2017. Meanwhile, white rice exports increased to 5.3 million metric tons, up 15 percent from the same period last year, driven by the sale of the remaining low-quality government rice stocks in the third quarter of 2018.

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding fragrant rice) for December 24-31, 2018 totaled 175,559 metric tons, down 75,226 metric tons from the previous week and down 35,147 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 210,706 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – December 31, 2018 totaled 9,497,418 metric tons.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, during May 1, 2013 - December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% - 100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
