Rice export prices increased slightly due mainly to the strengthening Thai baht. The Thai baht further strengthened to 31.6 baht/U.S. \$1.00 from the previous week's exchange rate of 31.7 baht/U.S. \$1.00. This has helped cause Thai rice prices to become U.S. \$40/MT higher than Vietnamese rice, compared to the previous week's price difference of U.S. \$20-25/MT.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding fragrant rice) for January 7-13, 2019 totaled 175,369 metric tons, up 83,079 metric tons from the previous week and up 2,299 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 173,070 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – 13, 2019 totaled 267,659 metric tons, down 10 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, during May 1, 2013 - December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% - 100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
