Export prices for most grades of rice declined 2-4 percent from the previous week due to a lack of new inquiries and weakening of the Thai baht from 31.07 baht/U.S. \$1.00 to 31.39 baht/U.S. \$1.00. Foreign buyers have reportedly reduced purchases of Thai white and parboiled rice in response to Thai rice prices escalating over the past couple of weeks. Presently, export prices of Thai white rice are U.S. \$10 per metric ton above Vietnamese rice.

Rice Export Update

According to the Thai Rice Exporter Association, Thai rice exports totaled 2.8 million metric tons during January 1 – March 31, 2018. This is a 3 percent increase from the same period last year due to the increase in white and parboiled rice exports (Table 2.1). Meanwhile, exports of fragrant rice declined 27 percent from the same period last year as the government sold almost all of its food-quality rice stocks in 2017.

Please note that weekly unofficial and preliminary rice exports for April 16-22, 2018 are not available due to the official holiday.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, during May 1, 2013 - December 18, 2016, export data and not include 25% - 100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the That Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thatland. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
