Report Highlights:

TH6069 – Export prices increased 2 to 4 percent due to new enquiries for parboiled rice amid tight supplies of white rice paddy for parboiled rice production. The government reportedly sold 1.1 million tons in its recent public tender for 2.2 million metric tons.

Export prices increased 2 to 4 percent from the previous week due to new enquiries for parboiled rice from African countries. Meanwhile, supplies of white rice paddy for parboiled rice production remain tight due to planting delays.

The Thai Government reported that it sold 1.1 million metric tons of food-grade rice in its public tender for 2.2 million metric tons issued on June 15, 2016. The sales mainly consisted of 5% grade white rice which is carry-over stocks under MY2011/12 and MY2012/13 pledging programs. The bids were finalized at around 11,000 baht per metric ton (\$314/MT) which is 20-30 percent below market prices of current crop. The government is reportedly holding rice stocks of around 9 million metric tons which consist of 3 million metric tons of food-grade rice and 6 million metric tons of industrial grade rice (including food processing and feed industries).

Rice Export Update

Unofficial preliminary rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) for June 20-26, 2016 totaled 69,746 metric tons, up 1,615 metric tons from the previous week and up 3,288 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 66,457 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – June 26, 2016 totaled 1,772,409 metric tons, down 5 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, starting May 1, 2013, the data will not include 100% - 25% grade white rice exports. The reporting authority was moved from the That Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official fragrant rice and white rice (100%-25% grades) export data. FAS/BKK will report only official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thatland. The reader should bear in mind the difference between the data.
