## Weekly Rice Price Update

#### **Report Highlights:**

TH6080 – Export prices declined 1 to 2 percent due to the sales of government rice stocks associated with the tender for 3.8 million metric tons on July 25. The government is expected to sell around 0.3 million metric tons of non-food grade rice and 0.7 million metric tons of sub-standard food grade rice for the domestic and export markets. Meanwhile, the result of the closed tender for export of 2.2 million metric tons will be announced on July 28.

Export prices declined 1 to 2 percent from the previous week due to the sales of government rice stock associated with the tender for 3.8 million metric ton issued on July 25, 2016. The Ministry of Commerce reported that seven exporters participated in the tender for 2.2 million metric tons of standard food-grade rice which will be exclusively for exports. The result of this closed tender will be announced on July 28. Meanwhile, 18 traders/exporters reportedly participated in another public tender for 1.6 million metric tons which consisted of 0.7 million metric tons of sub-standard food grade rice, and 0.9 million metric tons of non-food grade rice. The government is expected to sell around 1 million metric tons in this public tender which will consist of 0.3 million metric tons for feed and ethanol industries (mostly broken rice), and 0.7 million metric tons of sub-standard food grade rice for the domestic and export markets (mostly 5% grade white rice). The bids were reportedly 5,000 - 6,000 baht per metric ton (\$143-170/MT) for 5% grade white rice which is carry-over stocks under the MY2012/13 and MY2013/14 rice pledging programs.

#### **Rice Export Update**

Unofficial preliminary rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) for July 18-24, 2016 totaled 63,049 metric tons, up 30,152 metric tons from the previous week and up 14,635 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 48,414 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – July 24, 2016 totaled 1,966,064 metric tons, down 10 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, starting May 1, 2013, the data will not include 100% - 25% grade white rice exports. The reporting authority was moved from the That Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official fragrant rice and white rice (100%-25% grades) export data. FAS/BKK will report only official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thatland. The reader should bear in mind the difference between the data.
