Rice export prices remain unchanged from the previous week. Traders are waiting for the government to finalize the sale of 267,418 metric tons of rice stocks which were retendered on August 29-30, 2018. The sale will consist of (1) 245,077 metric tons of feed quality rice and (2) 22,341 metric tons of deteriorated rice and is expected to be finalized by the end of the week. Most of these government rice stocks are 5% grade white rice from the MY2011/12 - MY2012/13 pledging programs.

While it had been previously believed that the August 29-30, 2018 retender would sell all of the remaining government rice stocks, on September 10, 2018, the government reported that it still held another 655,000 metric tons of food-quality rice. While this rice was sold through tenders in 2017, buyers refused to accept the purchased rice due to concerns over quality. The government has yet to decide if these rice stocks will be retendered or not.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) for August 27 – September 2, 2018, totaled 190,028 metric tons, down 17,846 metric tons from the previous week and down 24,503 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 214,531 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – September 2, 2018 totaled 6,332,478 metric tons.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, during May 1, 2013 - December 18, 2016, export data and not include 25% - 100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
