Report Highlights:

On May 2, 2019, the Government of India's (GOI) Ministry of Finance (MOF) further deferred the implementation date, from May 2, 2019, to May 16, 2019, of the proposed increase in the basic custom duty (BCD) for exports of specific U.S. agricultural products (i.e. artemia, shelled and in-shell almonds, in-shell walnuts, fresh apples, and pulses).

On May 2, 2019, the MOF issued customs notification 14/2019 dated May 1, 2019, announcing a delay in the implementation of increases in the effective BCD for specific U.S. agricultural imports from May 2, 2019 to May 16, 2019. If implemented, these tariff increases would apply to exports of U.S.-origin shelled and in-shell almonds, in-shell walnuts, apples, artemia and pulses.
