TH9198 Despite steady domestic prices at high levels, export prices declined slightly due to the Thai baht weakening to 33.2 baht/\$. Thai rice exporters reportedly received some enquiries from foreign buyers who are normally customers of Vietnam.

Despite steady domestic prices at high levels, export prices declined slightly due to the Thai baht weakening to 33.2 baht/\$ from 33.0 baht/\$ the previous week. However, some quotations remained unchanged at 33.0 baht/\$ as the exchange rate is still volatile. Thai rice exporters reportedly received some enquiries from foreign buyers who are normally customers of Vietnam. These enquiries reflected tighter Vietnamese rice supplies driven by its large contracts of approximately 1.3 million tons of 25% grade white rice under the Philippines' tenders. Thailand will likely provide 0.5 million tons under these contracts. Thai rice exporters are fulfilling these contracts, particularly for the first shipment in January 2010 at approximately \$536/MT, FOB. Domestic prices were unchanged at high levels from the previous weeks as the government stock release plan remained uncertain.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial exports (excluding fragrant rice) for December 21-27, 2009 totaled 126,910 tons, up 6,456 tons from the previous week, and up 15,797 tons from the four-week moving average of 111,113 tons. Exports of white rice during January 1 – December 27, 2009 totaled 5,837,297 tons, as compared with 7,411,544 tons in the previous year.

According to the Department of Foreign Trade, Ministry of Commerce, total rice exports (including

fragrant rice) during January 1 - December 17, 2009 amounted to 8,236,067 tons, down 15.5 percent from 9,747,592 tons in the previous year.
