# **Weekly Rice Price Update**

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#### **Report Highlights:**

TH 1002 Domestic and export prices remain unchanged from the previous week as domestic and foreign markets have not fully resume trading activities due to New Year's holiday. The cabinet will likely approve an intervention stock release for export of 0.8 million tons of old-crop white rice 5 % grade to the top three exporters later this month.

Domestic and export prices remain unchanged from the previous week as most domestic and foreign market have not fully resume trading activities due to New Year's holiday. The shipments of 230,000 tons of white rice contract (dated December 7, 2010) to Indonesia are underway and will likely be fulfilled within January 2011. The cabinet is expected to approve an intervention stock release for export of 0.8 million tons of old-crop white rice 5% grade to the top three exporters later this month. Since July 2010, the government has released approximately 3.5 million tons (out of total intervention stocks of 5-6 million tons). Meanwhile, exchange rate fluctuation remains a concern among exporters as the Thai baht strengthened again to 29.85 baht/\$, compared to 30.05 baht/\$ in the previous week.

The government's weekly benchmark price for white rice for January 3-9, 2011 declined by 1.5 percent. As such, farmers will receive higher compensation compared to the previous week. Farmers that sell their supplies this week will be able to arbitrage as market prices are higher than benchmark prices.

#### **Rice Export Update**

Unofficial rice exports (excluding fragrant rice) for January 1-2, 2011 totaled 3,600 tons, up 260 percent from 1,000 tons in the previous year. Exports for December 27-31, 2010 totaled 155,420 tons, down 26,094 tons from the previous week, and down 15,466 tons from the four-week moving average of 170,886 tons. Exports of white rice and parboiled rice during January 1- December 31, 2010 totaled 6,648,669 tons, up 12.8 percent from 5,895,795 tons in the previous year.

According to the Department of Foreign trade, Ministry of Commerce, total rice exports (including
