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Report Name: US the Top Destination for Taiwan's Agricultural Exports in 1st Half 2022

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Report Highlights:

Taiwan exported \$511 million of agricultural & related products to the U.S. in 1st Half 2022 out of \$ 2.8 billion of total exports. Despite total exports declining by 7 percent year-on-year, exports to the U.S. increased 14 percent. Taiwan's major exports to the U.S. are in Consumer Oriented Categories including Bakery Goods, Cereals, & Pasta, Soup & Other Food Preparations and Seafood Products. The U.S. is expected to remain Taiwan's top export market for full year 2022.

U.S. the Top Destination for Taiwan's Agricultural Exports in 1st Half 2022

Taiwan exported \$511 million of agricultural & related products to the U.S. in the 1st half (1H) of 2022 out of \$2.8 billion of total exports. Despite total agricultural exports declining by 7 percent year-on-year, exports to the U.S. increased 14 percent. Over the same period exports to China declined by 40 percent in large part due to China's trade restrictions on major Taiwan agricultural and seafood exports.

According to Taiwan's Council of Agriculture (COA), this was the first time in 9 years where the U.S. took the top spot from China. Due to recent cross-strait tensions and ongoing trade disrupting actions, agricultural exports in 1H2022 to China (\$389 million, accounting for 14 percent market share) had fallen to 3rd place behind both the U.S. (\$511 million, 18 percent market share) and Japan (\$439 million, 15 percent market share). The U.S. is expected to remain the top export market for full year 2022.

Major exports to the US highlighted by COA includes baked pastries, edamame, shiitake mushrooms, fresh and chilled vegetables, honey, oncidium (orchids), phalaenopsis (orchids), sea bass and mackerel.

Local media also highlighted export growth to the U.S. in ingredients for bubble tea style drinks including tea, tapioca flour, pineapple, and mango Juice.

Currently, five Taiwan's fresh fruits are allowed to be exported to the U.S. including guava, mango, star fruit, longan, and lychee.

In 2021, Taiwan agricultural & related products exports to the U.S. were \$966 million in contrast to \$3.9 billion of U.S. agricultural & related product imports. Taiwan's largest export BICO categories included Soup & Other Food Preparations (\$186 million, accounting for 19 percent), Seafood Products (\$182 million, 19 percent) and Bakery Goods, Cereals & Pasta (\$151 million, 16 percent).

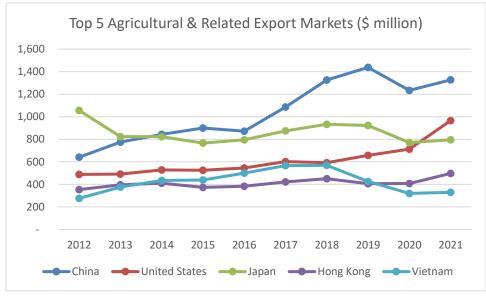
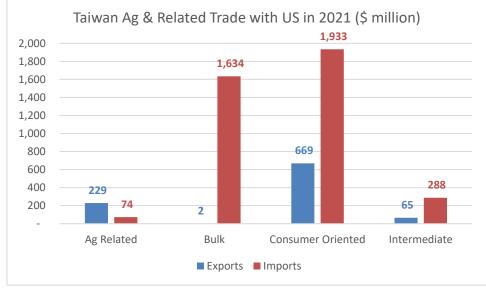


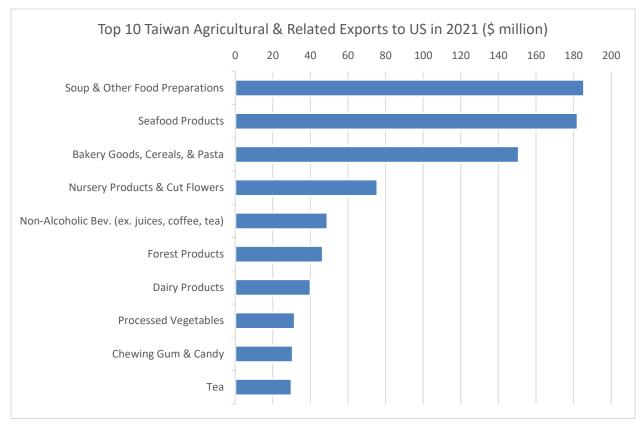
Chart 1: Taiwan's Top Agricultural & Related Export Markets

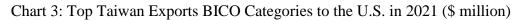
