Report Highlights:

The U.S.-Japan Trade Agreement (USJTA) entered Year 5 of the agreement implementation on April 1, 2023. This report is one in a series of product briefs highlighting the tariff benefits for specific commodities and products from Year 5 (2023) to Year 7 (2025) of the Agreement. Overview: In 2022, the United States exported \$32 million of prepared or preserved fruit (excluding jams) to Japan, making Japan the #5 overseas market. For jams, see the Fruit Juice and Jams product brief. Japan relies on imports for nearly 90 percent of its demand for processed fruit. The United States accounted for seven percent of Japan’s total prepared and preserved fruit imports. The years below correspond to Japan’s fiscal year beginning April 1.
