Wheat Production Update

Report Highlights:

Uzbekistan wheat production in MY 2011/12 is forecast at 6.3 million metric tons (MMT), slightly lower than in the previous year. About 60 percent of the crop is considered to be of milling quality. Both wheat and wheat flour from Kazakhstan entered Uzbekistan through official and some unofficial channels. Wheat, wheat flour, and bread prices have all risen sharply in the past few months, presumably in keeping with rising world prices and because of the increasing pace of inflation.

Production

Uzbekistan's MY11/12 wheat harvest was completed in the last week of July. The estimated planted area of 1.4 million ha equaled that of the previous year. Of this, irrigated land was approximately 1.14 million ha. According to preliminary official figures, MY11/12 wheat production reached 6.52 million tons (MMT). However, various independent sources indicate that official wheat production figures are slightly overestimated. Reportedly a few regions in southern and northern parts of the country have failed to achieve state targets for grain production because of unusually dry weather and limited availability of irrigation water. Based on these facts, Post preliminarily forecasts MY2011/12 wheat production at 6.3 MMT. This year's official state procurement price was set up at the level of 287,000 Sums/ton which is for 50,000 Sums more than in MY 2010/11. However, due to water related problems and lower than expected yields in some regions, the local market prices for wheat went up as high as 1000 Sums per kg.

According to independent experts, only an estimated 55 to 60 percent of locally produced wheat is suitable for food use. The remainder is used for feed and other purposes. Many private bakers prefer using Kazakh wheat flour, which is a better quality.

Consumption

In MY2011/12 food wheat consumption is forecast at 6.3 MMT. There are no official data on feed grain consumption in Uzbekistan, and expert estimates vary from 1.25 to 1.3 MMT. Because of inflation and in keeping with rising world prices, local wheat flour prices increased continuously from the beginning of the year. In the 1st quarter of 2011 the price of the highest grade of wheat flour was Uzbek Sums (UZS) 2500/kg; by July it reached UZS 3200/kg, a 28 percent increase. This has increased the demand for local wheat flour. Consequently, bread prices have risen as well by almost 10 percent, mainly for local flat bread ("non") sold by private bakeries.

Trade

There are no official statistics available on wheat trade. According to trade sources, Uzbekistan's MY 2010/11 wheat exports are estimated at 450,000 tons of lower grade wheat. MY 2011/12 exports are forecast at 400,000 tons. The export destinations are reportedly Iran, Afghanistan and Azerbaijan. Uzbekistan's MY 2010/11 wheat imports are estimated at 1.35 MMT and MY 2011/12 wheat imports are forecast at 1.4 MMT. Kazakhstan remains the main supplier of high quality wheat and wheat flour to Uzbekistan.
