Report Highlights:

Export rice prices were still rising strongly last week. The Vietnam Food Association announced the guidance prices for 5 percent broken rice at \$400 per ton and 25 percent broken rice at \$370 per ton.

Local paddy prices also increased further last week. However, in some provinces in the Mekong River Delta, the increases in paddy prices have slowed over the last two weeks.
