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Preferential Import Tariffs Increase

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Report Highlights:

Since early 2010, the Government of Vietnam (GVN) has imposed an array of trade limiting measures to try and reduce its trade deficit. The Ministry of Finance's (MOF) Circular 133, which was published September 9, 2010, and entered into force (EIF) on October 25, 2010, appears to be yet another measure designed to curb imports.

Via Circular 133, Vietnam increased the Preferential Import Tariff Rates (or MFN Tariff rates) on a number of imported products including several agricultural products from Global Harmonized System Chapters 2, 7, 8, 16, 18, 19 and 20. Despite the higher rates, Post does not believe U.S. market share will be negatively impacted because most of the tariff changes are small, and for products with large tariff rate changes the United States is already at an enormous tariff disadvantage relative to its competition within ASEAN.

General Information:

On September 9, 2010, Vietnam's Ministry of Finance (MOF) issued Circular 133/2010/TT-BTC to revise the levels of Preferential Import Tariffs (i.e. MFN tariff) listed in MOF's Circular 216/2009/TT-BTC dated November 12, 2009. The increase of MFN tariff rates for specific agricultural products in Global Harmonized System Chapters 2, 7, 8, 16, 18, 19, 20 ranges from 1 to 12 percent. For example, the new MFN tariff rate applied to grapefruit increased to 40 percent from a current rate of 30 percent, while the MFN tariff rate for major fruit juices including orange, pineapple, tomato, and grape juice was revised to 34 percent from the current rate of 25 percent. The new MFN tariffs published in Circular 133/2010/TT-BTC went into effect on October 25, 2010, 45 days after the Circular's signing date.

Although Post believes Circular 133 is but another GVN measure designed to slow imports, the new rates are ultimately not expected to have a significant impact on the U.S. market share of affected products for the following two reasons:

- 1. The rise in MFN tariffs are small. This measure effects 130 agricultural tariff lines, of which 114 (88 percent) change 4 percent, or less.
- 2. The largest MFN changes are applied to products where the United States is not particularly competitive. Of the 16 tariff changes that are greater than 4 percent, 14 are applied to products related to fruits and fruit juices where the United States already faces stiff competition from countries (such as Thailand) that fall under the Common Effective Preferential Tariff (CEPT) Scheme for the ASEAN Free Trade Area (AFTA). AFTA competitors are subject to tariffs of 5 percent on these products instead of 18 percent or 40 percent.
