Report Highlights:

On January 4, 2016, India notified to the World Trade Organization (WTO) its draft regulation regarding the removal of zinc from its list of metal contaminants. The comment period for trading partners expires on March 4, 2016.

On November 23, 2015, GOI's Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) amended the <u>Food Safety and Standards (Contaminants, Toxins and Residues) Regulations, 2011</u>, to remove zinc from its list of metal contaminants. On January 4, 2016, the amended draft regulation was notified to the WTO. The comment period for trading partners expires on March 4, 2016.

In the table under sub-Regulation 2.1.1 of the <u>Food Safety and Standards (Contaminants, Toxins and Residues)</u> Regulations, 2011, serial number (5) related to zinc is deleted.
